(1938 - 1978)




In 1959, Mr. Robert Luxner began his teaching career at GLHS. Last August, death ended those 19 years of dedicated teaching.

A dedicated teacher, a loving husband and father, and an active and concerned citizen, Mr. Robert Luxner, will be fondly remembered by many people for many years.






















# **Cross Country**

For the first time since 1949, the Greater Latrobe Basketball Team won its Section title and advanced into the W.P.I.A.L. playoffs. With only one returning starter from last years squad, the Cats built a strong nucleus around such senior members as Mike Ferguson, Paul Canterna, Jeff Regula, Jeff Yunetz, Dennis Reiner, Butch Huber and Greg Bakich. Although these seven boys will be missed greatly by Coach Zsolcsak, they will be remembered for the tremendously exciting and rewarding season they gave to the Latrobe fans.







# Wrestling

The 1978-79 Wildcat Wrestling Team finished with an impressive 17-1 record.
