






Faculty Fun


We often talked over life's great problems: 'How can I



As it turned out, we didn't go undefeated in most of the sports, and we didn't stay the Keystone Conference Champions. But this year was an accomplishment in many ways.



After the third year, head Coach Scott Downs and assistant Dave Mink had their second winning season (6-5-I).






AFS Students
